2. The TAG issued JFTX P15-08, Personally Owned Firearms policy on 17 December 2015 outlining those circumstances where TXSG personnel may and may not exercise their License to Carry (LTC) rights under the new law which took effect this month.

4. The TAG has directed that each soldier be briefed on this policy NLT 29 January 2016.

- b. Document the training per TXSG 3500.

- c. Report complete in writing.

- d. Suspense is 29 January 2016.
